FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

JUNE 27, 2011

This afternoon, June 27, 2011, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of Iowa triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from Flooding which occurred May 25, 2011, and continuing. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number: FEMA-1998-DR

Incident: Flooding

Incident Period: May 25, 2011, and continuing

Federal Coordinating Officer: Michael R. Scott
National FCO Program

Public Assistance (PA): Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities.

PA - Designated Counties: Fremont, Harrison, Mills, Monona, Pottawattamie, and Woodbury Counties for debris removal and emergency protective measures (Categories A and B), including direct Federal Assistance, under the Public Assistance program.

Hazard Mitigation (HM): Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long-term risk to life and property from natural hazards.

HM - Designated Boroughs: All counties in the State of Iowa are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER: Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
