

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Congressman Steve King has been recognized as a "True Blue" Member of Congress by Family Research Council Action for unwavering commitment and consistent support in defense of the family.

The award honors Members of Congress who have exhibited extraordinary leadership and commitment to the defense of family, faith, and freedom, according to FRC Action's scorecard covering the votes of the 110th Congress. Recipients of the "True Blue" Award voted consistently for pro-life and pro-family issues.

These votes included:

- Prohibition on Funding Human Cloning
- Federal Hate Crimes Act
- Maintain Mexico City Policy on International Abortion Funding
- Employment Non-Discrimination Act
- Restrict Funding to Planned Parenthood
- Prevent DC Same-sex "Marriage"
- Prohibit Funding for Washington DC Needle Exchange Program
