

Washington D.C.- Congressman Steve King (R-IA) announced today that the town hall meeting previously scheduled to occur on August 10 in Sioux City will be rescheduled in the wake of Speaker Pelosi's decision to call Congress into session for votes on that day.

“While I would prefer to host the town hall meeting in Sioux City as scheduled, circumstances dictate that I return to Washington for votes on that day,” said King. **“I appreciate the interest that has been shown by constituents planning on attending the Sioux City event, and I am currently working to find a suitable time, date and location that will allow me to reschedule it. As soon as these details are ironed out, I will announce the new schedule.”**
