

Washington D.C.- Congressman Steve King (R-IA) released the following statement to commemorate the opening of a new section of four-lane U.S. 20 between Rockwell City and Moorland. Congressman King's top transportation priority as a Member of Congress is the completion of four-lane U.S. 20 statewide from Sioux City to Dubuque.
