

Washington D.C.- Congressman Steve King (R-IA) released the following statement after the House voted today to pave the way for a vote on ObamaCare repeal legislation on Wednesday, January 12. The legislation incorporates Congressman King's ObamaCare repeal bill and will be offered by Republican Leader Eric Cantor.

**“When ObamaCare passed, I introduced a bill that provided for the full repeal of ObamaCare as if ‘such act had not been enacted,’”** said King. **“Today, the House voted to bring that language to the floor for a vote. I look forward to this historic House vote in support of my repeal language, and I will continue to work on ObamaCare repeal until the day ObamaCare is finally and fully uprooted from the U.S. Code.”**
