

Washington D.C.- Congressman Steve King (R-IA) released the following statement following today's announcement that the House of Representatives will hold a vote on King's ObamaCare repeal language next week. King's language will be brought to the floor by House Majority Leader Eric Cantor as part of H.R. 2, the Repealing the Job Killing Health Care Law Act. The House will take up the repeal legislation next Tuesday after having temporarily suspended legislative activities out of respect for the victims of the recent shootings in Arizona.

**“The House will vote next week on my ObamaCare repeal language,”** said King. **“By the end of next week, we will have passed my language repealing ObamaCare ‘as if such Act had not been enacted,’ and Americans will be one step closer to seeing their calls for the total repeal of the law answered.”**

**“The effort to repeal ObamaCare will not end with this vote,”** King continued. **“Repeal efforts will continue until the law is fully uprooted from the U.S. Code. By passing my repeal language as one of its first acts, the House will ensure that momentum for repealing ObamaCare will continue to build.”**
