

Washington D.C.- Congressman Steve King (R-IA) released the following statement after being named a "Defender of Liberty" by the American Conservative Union (ACU). King was presented with the "Defender of Liberty Award" by ACU Chairman Al Cardenas. The ACU awards the title of "Defender of Liberty" based on an analysis of congressional votes on issues that are of particular importance to grassroots conservatives. For votes cast in 2010, King received a total of 96 points out of a possible 100.
